Northside's Family Connections Program strives to provide the mental, behavioral, and structural support families need to prevent children from entering the foster care system. Case Planners trained in the Evidenced Based Model of Family Connections work with parents and caregivers to implement crisis-based services and counseling within the family unit, strengthening them. Changed focused interventions, coping strategies, community resources, and concrete needs support are part of the wrap around services provided to ensure child safety and family stability.
